7. Which fowls can we eat? Deuteronomy 14:20.
8. What will happen to those found eating swine's flesh and the mouse when the Lord comes? Isaiah 66:15-17.
9. What was in the sheet that Peter saw coming down from heaven? Acts 10:12; 11:6.
10. What was Peter's reply to the voice that said, "Kill and Eat?" Acts 11:8; 10:14.
11. Do we find that the last book to the church revelations still references unclean birds? Revelations 18:2.

Scripture Reading: Luke 22:1-20.

Golden Text: John 6:53.

2. When was Jesus betrayed? Matthew 26:2; Luke 22:21, 47-48.
3. At what time of the year and on what day of the month was the Passover observed? Deuteronomy 16:1, 6; Numbers 28:16; 33:3.
4. Did Jesus compare Himself to the manna that was given to Israel in the wilderness? John 6:30-34.
5. What did Jesus call the cup? Luke 22:20.
6. What must our preparation be before partaking of the Lord's Supper? Who is to be the judge whether one may partake of it? 1 Corinthians 11:26-31; 2 Corinthians 13:5-7; Galatians 6:4.
7. What example did Jesus leave for us just prior to administering the bread and fruit of the vine? John 13:4-5.
8. Before we can partake of the emblems, from what must we purge ourselves? 1 Corinthians 5:6-8; Galatians 5:9.
9. Is it essential that every child of God partake of these sacred emblems? John 6:53-58.
10. If Jesus waited for a specific time to introduce his remembrance should we not keep that same time? Luke 22:15.
