

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

I. Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.

II. V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.


VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.



The Secret of Bible Study

Study IT through - Never begin a day without reading and understanding one of the questions of the next Sabbath's Lesson.

Pray about IT - Never leave your Bible until the text you have read and studied is a part of your very being.

Write IT down - The thoughts that God gives you put it on your margin or in a note book, etc. Refer to this when having the review or the study of the lesson in Sabbath school.

Work IT out - Live the truth you receive throughout the rest of the day and think about it as you go to sleep.

Pass IT on - Seek to tell somebody, your family, neighbour or friend, what you have learned and perhaps your listener will start to do the same thing as you. You will surely soon after have the beginnings of a Sabbath school.

MIRACLES

Because of the greatness and magnificence of the Bible, there are many ways by which we can approach it, and in our quest for truth we should guard ourselves against becoming slaves of any one method of study.

What a prodigal variety of themes the Bible presents for our prayerful and patient meditation, some of which belong on an ex-ceptional level. They stand out by themselves in a separate group. They remind us of mountain peaks which, however separate, are parts of one range, by their very altitude and solitariness attracting special notice.

Is such an observation not true of the miracles of the Bible, which go to make it the most fascinating, authentic record in the world? While the border line between the natural and supernatural may, in some manifestations, be so thin that a perfectly complete list of miracles would depend on one's definition of a miracle, we have a galaxy easily distinguishable as miraculous.

6. Gideon had assembled 32,000 men to fight the Midianites. What did God say about this number? Judges 7:2, 3.

7. What did God say then to Gideon? Judges 7:4-6.

8. To what number did God reduce Gideon's army? Judges 7:7-8.

6. How was Israel fed after their murmuring? Exodus 16:9-13.

7. How did Israel receive their water? Exodus 17:5, 6.

8. How were there shoes and clothing provided? Deuteronomy 29:4, 5.

9. What was the miracle of the cloud and fire? Exodus 40:34, 38; Psalms 78:10-17; 1 Corinthians 10:1-4.
