II Corinthians 6:14-18

Verse 14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

Verse 15 And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

Verse 16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in *them*; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Verse 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you,

Verse 18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Revelation 18:4

Verse 4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Here we are told we need to separate ourselves from the world and be not partakers of sin to be received by God. You need to choose who you want to serve.

Matthew 6:24

Verse 24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

I Corinthians 10:21

Verse 21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

James 4:4-7

Verse 4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

Verse 5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?

Verse 6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

Verse 7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

I John 2:15-17

Verse 15 Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

Verse 16 For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

Verse 17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

Loving the world and the things in it will make us an enemy of God. We must resist the devil and serve God.

We will be persecuted and hated for what we believe, serving God will be difficult. You just need to stand strong for your beliefs and you will be rewarded.

Matthew 10:22

Verse 22 And ye shall be hated of all *men* for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

John 15:18-19

Verse 18 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before *it hated* you.

Verse 19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

Romans 6:23

Verse 23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 12:18

Verse 18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.
