God's Word

This Bible study is designed to introduce God's word, as the only foundation for the true Christian to build their beliefs on. Many churches teach that they are fundamentalist, yet they have changed God's word to suite their own doctrine, rather than making sure that their doctrine coincides with God's word and the life of Jesus.

Is God's word changeable?

Deuteronomy 4:2; Deuteronomy 12:32; Joshua 1:7; Proverbs 30:6; Ecclesiastes 12:13; Revelation 22:18,19

Deuteronomy 4:2 Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

Revelation 22:18,19

18 For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

What guides us through the darkness of life?

Psalms 119:103-105

103 How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

104 Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.

105 Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

2 Peter 1:19,20

19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

Has mankind always had God's word to be their guide?

Genesis 3:3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

(From the very time of Adam and Eve we have had God's word for our guide).

Psalms 11:3 If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do? (Churches who change Bible doctrine are eroding God's word and our foundation!)

If we follow man's word or doctrine where does that leave us in our Lord's judgement?

Matthew 15:9 But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

Does Jesus change?

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Can we walk with God and not be one mind with Him?

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

We must be as the Bereans.

Acts 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

It is not enough to just go to church we have an obligation to search the scripture and see if what we have been told is biblically based.

We must remember that Jesus had a great concern of the false Christ that would come after Him. We must be sure we are honouring and obeying the teaching of the true Christ, which can only be done through God's written word.

Is God's word changeable?
