III. Thou shalt not take the Name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh His Name in vain.

IV. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbour's.

The Secret of Bible Study

GOD IS ONE, FATHER OF ALL (PART ONE)

Scripture Reading: 1 Corinthians 1-7; Deuteronomy 6:14

Golden Text: Deuteronomy 6:4

Summary: Three-Headed and Three-Faced Trinities are depictions of God under an anthropomorphic appearance sharing one single body, but expressing their triple nature through a multiplication of either heads or faces. The Three-Headed and Three-Faced Trinities can be attached to a full body or they can appear on busts. The perfect equivalence and sameness of the three *persons* was the theological thesis that encouraged this iconography. Nevertheless, the representation of an image with more than one head was also a feature of medieval diabolic depictions that later on made Counterreformation artists avoid the use of this iconography. **Primary sources:** The notion of the Trinity.

4. We have other text that reference this time line but not clearly how should we explain them? Matthew 26:61; 27:40; 27:63; Mark 8:31; 14:58.

5. What does John have to say about that Sabbath? John 19:31 Check the reading in the ASV if you have one.

6. After Jesus crucifixion the woman bought and prepared spices to anoint Jesus body when did they buy the spices before or after the sabbath? Mark 16:1.

7. When did they take the spices to anoint Jesus body before or after the sabbath? Luke 23:54-56; 24:1.

8. The question we must consider is can you buy spices after the Sabbath and prepare them before the Sabbath as the last two question would suggest?

9. When on the road to Emmaus what do the men tell Jesus? Luke 24:13-21.

10. If we take this information which we have gathered over these questions what time line best keeps with Jesus prophecy of his death and resurrection? Late Wednesday to late Saturday or late Friday to early Sunday?

SABBATH STUDY MAY 11, 2019

Scripture Reading: Luke 1:1-26

Golden Text: Matthew 2:2

1. What was Zacharias course to serve in the Temple: Luke 1:5.
2. What was the course of Abijah? 1 Chronicles 24:3, 10.
3. When does the Jewish new year start? Exodus 12:1, 2. Can we determine the actual season? Exodus 9:31, 32.
4. How did the courses work for the priest? 1 Chronicles 24:4, 5.
